Caller 2 THERE IS A FIGHT ON THE ROAD OUTSIDE THE BULAN BAR, MALE LOOKS LIKE HE HAS BEEN KNOCKED OUT, MAN WHO ATTACKED HIM IS TALKING TO BOUNCERS WEARING GREY SHORTS, GREY AND WHITE HOODIE, OVER 6FT, BALD, BEARD

CCTV shows

A male was escorted out of BULAN bar, DALE ROAD as the bouncers have caught him with white powder in the toilets on being escorted out he swings out and hits one of the bouncers in the shoulder with a punch.

IP does not support any type of prosecution and does not wish to give a statement, A small tissue with white powder was seized from BULAN and has been sent for destruction.

Caller 1 TAA-9295-23-3030-01 - WITNESS TO AN ASSAULT - CCTV AVAILABLE BUT VICTIM DOES NOT APPEAR TO HAVE COME FORWARD

Caller 2 - were disturbed by people shouting as they left Bulan (previously Harveys), they walk down the road towards Monk Bar. Meeting a group of people walking from Monk towards Bulan, shouting started and then 2 of the group started fighting. They took their jackets off and were circling, throwing punches and shoving each other into the wall and Evans Jewellers shutters. Other members of the group, still shouting, tried to pull them apart, they then ran round the parked cars and into the road, stopping traffic. At this point I called 999, the fighting continued about 5 minutes more and then they all walk back into Bulan, and the police arrive.

The CCTV has been viewed as detailed in document 21A. It shows the male being ejected and a number of security gathering round him for some time. One doorman in particular is very threatening towards the male demanding to know who he got his drugs from and making threats towards him. Luke Taylor is seen approaching from the entrance and at the point the male discloses a name the doorstaff go back into the club. The male walks up the road a short distance. Within seconds they speak with a male with a beard who comes out of the club. This male then walks up to the ejected male, throws him to the floor and punches him a number of times whilst the doorstaff look on. The male with the beard returns to the club and fist pumps a doorman before going back inside the club.

The door staff appear to be in sight of this incident and the male that had been assaulted stays on the floor for some time without any assistance.

Outcome – Suspect charged

Shows the doorstaff on right going back into club after males tells them where the drugs came from. (Victim left)





CCTV

I have viewed CCTV RJP/1 and it is 8min 34 seconds in duration. It clearly shows the assault on the victim which takes place in the middle of the road. Door security are involved in trying to deal with the incident and are seen to provide help to the victim. The doorstaff appear to be wearing their SIA armbands but are not wearing any high visibility tabards or body worn cameras.

The victims were taken by EMAS to hospital for treatment.

Male victim as a result has 2 front teeth missing, lumps to his forehead, swollen cheekbone, stamp mark on cheek and chest as well as strangulation marks to the neck.

Female victim received a tear to the back of her left ear which had to be glued. She had a black eye and bruising to her back and swelling to her right hip.

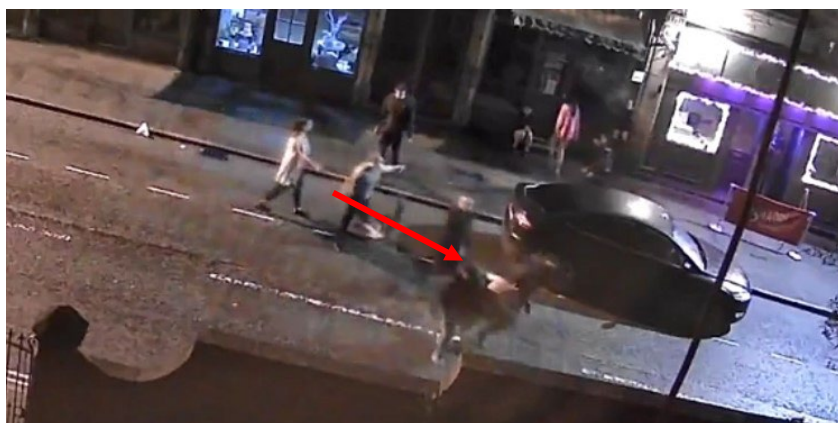

I am a Detective Staff Investigator based at Chesterfield CID. I am also the officer in the case regarding an incident that occurred at BULAN nightclub, 119-121 DALE ROAD, MATLOCK, DE43LU, in the early hours of SATURDAY 22ND APRIL 2023. During this incident, 2 individuals were assaulted by 3 suspects. The incident began inside BULAN and continued onto the street immediately outside of BULAN. Police occurrence number 23*241222 refers.

Multiple CCTV exhibits have been seized during the course of this investigation, which show the events that occurred both inside and outside BULAN. This investigation is currently ongoing, and as such some specific details will not be disclosed as a result. As a general summary; an incident broke out within BULAN main bar area between [REDACTED] and 3 other individuals; 2 males and 1 female, just after 02:00 hours. A further female was also involved, who is the mother of [REDACTED] and a member of staff at BULAN at the time of the incident.

The incident began when the club was closing and everyone was told to leave by staff. [REDACTED] was pushed and fell onto a table, after which point a brawl occurred. This included [REDACTED] mother being assaulted by being pushed to the ground, having her hair pulled and being punched. Security separated the 2 parties, pulling [REDACTED] to the back of the nightclub and removing the other individuals out the front entrance.

[REDACTED] then decided to let himself out of the back yard of BULAN via the rear gate and run back round to the front entrance of the nightclub. As [REDACTED] approaches the suspects on DALE ROAD, he stops still, before the female suspect runs towards [REDACTED] and punches him. This was followed by [REDACTED] being repeatedly assaulted by all 3 suspects; being punched and kicked, thrown to the floor and stamped on.

This occurred directly outside of Bulan. Injuries caused consisted of multiple bruises and abrasions to [REDACTED] body and his 2 front teeth being knocked out. Police were called at 0223 and arrived at 0232, by which point the suspects had left the area. [REDACTED] received first aid from BULAN staff until paramedics arrived.

The CCTV covering the incident shows that the staff within BULAN made good attempts to break up the violence on the night of the incident. Door staff and bar staff were involved in attempting to prevent further violence and took steps to separate the involved parties. Staff also participated in providing first aid to the injured male who was lying in the road following the assault.

The owner of BULAN, Luke TAYLOR, has been assisting Police with enquiries into the incident. He has cooperated with Police and provided a statement covering the incident. He has also agreed to take part in identification procedures should that be necessary. However, TAYLOR has at times been vague and evasive on certain points, such as whether the victims in this case were actually customers or employees at the time of the incident. He initially lead Police to believe that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were customers, before giving a statement describing that [REDACTED] was actually working on the night in question.

The investigation has also been frustrated by CCTV enquiries made at BULAN and RUBIGO. Although TAYLOR has cooperated in providing CCTV from BULAN, there has been one important omission. The camera covering one particular room in BULAN was not operational at the time of the incident, which was confirmed by TAYLOR. The investigation is still ongoing at this time, so I cannot make further comment regarding the relevance of this. Also, the CCTV footage at BULAN has also not been of sufficient quality to produce good quality still images of all those involved.

In addition to the above CCTV issue at BULAN, I have also failed in my attempts to secure CCTV footage from sister premises RUBIGO, which I believe is also owned by Luke TAYLOR. As the investigation progressed, it was apparent that CCTV from RUBIGO may be able to assist in the investigation. However, when I attended RUBIGO and checked the CCTV in company with TAYLOR, the footage only saved on the system for 7 days, rather than the 28-day typical standard. This meant the relevant footage had been erased and this has further frustrated enquiries.

Whilst conducting enquiries in the local area of BULAN, I have also been made aware of concerns from the local residents regarding the disorder. The location of BULAN is immediately facing a row of residential family properties. One resident I have spoken to has expressed concerns around the frequency of violent

disorder at BULAN, stating that there are fights outside every month. Residents are extremely frustrated with having to report fights several times a month and being required to provide statements about serious assaults. The fights are said to be getting more serious and residents are worried about the safety of their family and the general disruption caused to their lives. The operation of BULAN is therefore clearly causing a public nuisance and is a risk to the wellbeing of children living in the local area.
